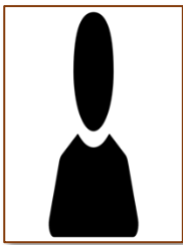

Andy Weber: Dedicated his professional life to countering nuclear, chemical, and biological threats and to strengthening global health security. His thirty years of US government service included five-and-a-half years as Assistant Secretary of Defense for Nuclear, Chemical and Biological Defense Programs. He was a driving force behind Nunn-Lugar Cooperative Threat Reduction efforts to remove weapons-grade uranium from Kazakhstan and

Georgia and nuclear-capable MiG-29 aircraft from Moldova, to reduce biological weapons threats, and to destroy Libyan and Syrian chemical weapons stockpiles. In addition, he coordinated US leadership of the international Ebola response for the Department of State. Prior to joining the Pentagon as Advisor for Threat Reduction Policy in December 1996, Mr. Weber was posted abroad as a CIA Officer in Saudi Arabia, Germany, COS/Kazakhstan, and Hong Kong.
