Anna B. Puglisi



Anna B. Puglisi is currently a Senior Fellow at Georgetown's Center for Security and Emerging Technology. She was the National Counterintelligence Officer for East Asia, where she served as the Senior Advisor to the Director of the National Counterintelligence and Security Center and worked with academia and the private sector to protect the national innovation base. She previously served as a

Senior Analyst at CIA, where she developed both a multidisciplinary effort to understand global technology development and its impact of US competitiveness and national security, as well as mitigation strategies for protecting the US innovation base. As chair of the relevant inter-agency committee, Anna briefed senior U.S. policymakers at the highest level on issues involving technology transfer and innovation. She was awarded the FBI Director's award for her efforts. She has an MPA and MS in environmental science from Indiana University, and a BA with Honors in Biology and has worked in research and technical infrastructure. Ms. Puglisi also studied at the Princeton in Beijing Chinese language school and was a visiting scholar in Nankai University's Department of Economics, where she studied China's S&T policies, infrastructure development, and university reforms. She is a co-author of the 2013 study "Chinese Industrial Espionage," the first book-length treatment of the topic. A 2020 update is about to be released.
